The spiritual battles these last few months have caused many tears, wounding and sleepless nights but to see the victories they are walking in now was worth it all.

Our Freedom Textiles team has been praying for a specific apartment to open up around the corner from our office/training centre for girls coming through our discipleship/training program. We recently acquired the apartment. It is now furnished and ready to receive up to three more girls once they are released from the Juvenile Detention Centre and wanting to join our program. God is good. Please pray as we discern who God is inviting into the program.

We are dreaming of adding a hair dressing option to our program. We trust that God will stir the hearts of future Thai leaders, teachers, disciplers and mentors to join us and the vision God has given us.

Thank you for your continued prayers for the journey Maceo and I are on. It has just been confirmed that I will be coming home for two weeks in October to connect with churches and supporters and then plan to be home for my full Missionaries in North America (MINA) in January.

Next month my lawyer and I will go into the prison in Bangkok to have Maceo's birth mom sign documents and to plead our case with guards to let her out for a day to go to City Hall. She must be there in person to sign documents. Thank you for continued prayers for miracles and finances for this adoption process to soon be completed.

Another praise is Year was recently baptized at our MB family camp along with Bon who is the boyfriend of Belle, another girl in our program. God is good. This are getting saved, disciplined, baptized and in turn sharing their faith with friends and family. It is such a privilege to be church planting among the least reached and seeing the Kingdom of God revealed and bring light and truth and freedom in the darkest of places.
