Jesus the One and Only – A Beth Moore Study

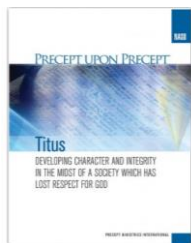
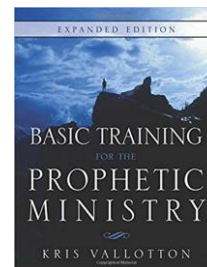
Linda and Clara, Room 3002. Book fee \$22.

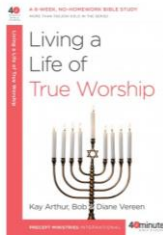
From Sunflowers to Seed Sowers

Living a Life of True Worship

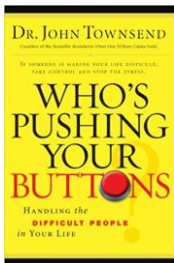
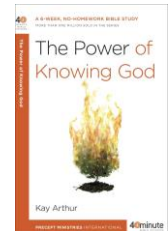
Etta and Lolita, Room 3012. Book fee \$14
